I salute the spirit of competition.

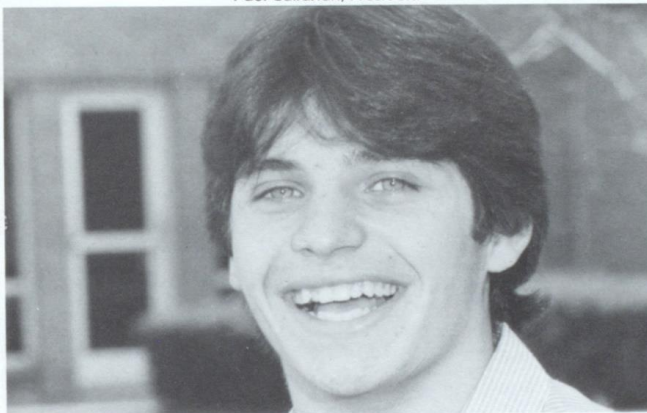
